Course on Writing Academic English

Course objective

To improve students' ability to communicate in written English about their topics of interest in the field of education.

Course schedule

Four-month course, comprising one 2-hour classroom meeting per month on selected themes and follow-up assignments and discussion over the Internet.

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Assignments

Students will be expected to complete 1-2 short assignments per week and one longer (10-page) research paper on a topic of interest. Quizzes and in-class assignments will

also be given. Students will also be expected to complete assigned reading of the text, Writing Academic English, by Alice Oshima and Ann Hogue (New York: Addison Wesley Longman, 1999), and printed handouts.

10 students

Student selection

Applicants for the course will be sent questions by e-mail to which they must respond in English. The ten participants will be chosen on the basis of these responses.

Course fees

Monthly tuition: Member: \$16,000 Non-member: \$18,000 (Total course tuition: Member: \$64,000 Non-member: \$72,000

- The above course fees include the cost of the text, Writing Academic English. The text will be distributed at the first class meeting.
- Because the course includes considerable on-line follow-up, participants unable to attend the monthly class meetings are expected to pay full tuition. In this case, course materials distributed at the monthly meeting will be sent to the participant.
